**Discussion Highlights:**

RFATS Safety Partners met yesterday, discussing the same presentation from the 9/26 RFATS Policy Committee meeting, and soliciting safety partner feedback.

- Public Meeting on Safe Street 4 All
- Citizen Input meeting was yesterday
- Duda spoke with Feemster who was going to look into pedestrian and cyclist safety measures on the 21 near FMHS

Pennies 5 road project from Peach Stand/hospital to bridge along neighborhoods and housing authorities, spurring off to FMHS and Harris Street Park

- Tentative design: 5-lane road, 6-foot bike path, curb, gutter, attached 5-foot sidewalk

**Speed limit discussion**

- Coughenour video says, Approved 55 mph - let what the engineers come back with be the speed - York County Council approved the exception
- Should we ask them to keep Cherry Road at 40 all through Riverwalk through the hospital?
- Feemster highlighted that speed limit is posted as 85% of standard speed
- 45 at Riverwalk
- Couchenour spoke with Mr. Johnston of SCDOT who asked what Scott thought the speed should be
- Speed limit at Carowinds to Captain Steve? 45 to 55?
- Coltharp is 45 with a new light

**Fort Mill overlay: 8-foot sidewalks at least 8 feet off of the road**

- Pennies approved attached 5 foot sidewalks. Please match the Fort Mill overlay or get closer to it.
- Requested that York County work with Fort Mill to match overlay.
